



COVID-19 Vaccinations Available to Homebound Individuals

North Shore Senior Center is partnering with AgeOptions and the Cook County Department of Public Health (CCDPH) to provide in-home COVID-19 vaccinations for suburban Cook County residents who are unable to leave home due to age, disability, or medical impairment.*

To be eligible for this program you must live in the jurisdiction of CCDPH (all of Cook County except for Chicago, Skokie, Evanston, Oak Park and Stickney) and:

Be a senior (65+) OR a person with a disability who requires in-home assistance.

OR

Have to use adaptive equipment (like a ventilator, crutches, a walker, a wheelchair, etc.) and/or accessible transportation to leave home.

AND

Leaving home is not an option for you because doing so requires considerable and taxing effort.

*NOTE: The quickest way to get a vaccine is to participate in a vaccination clinic outside of the home. There are options for drive-through clinics where no additional walking is required. To see other vaccination options visit <https://vaccine.cookcountyil.gov/> or call **833-308-1988**.

After sign-up, you will receive a confirmation email or phone call from one of CCDPH's COVID-19 Vaccine Provider Partners to schedule your in-home vaccination when the vaccine is available to you. Please be patient as we respond to a large number of requests.
