Day Program, Virtual Activities & Caregiver Support

Day Program Sessions & Rates

The Day Program is open Monday through Friday. Families can choose from morning, afternoon, or full-day options. Participants must attend a minimum of two sessions per week. To secure a spot, a one-month payment in advance is required.

Morning: 9 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.
\$100/Day; Lunch included

Afternoon: 1 - 5 p.m.
\$100/Day

Full Day: 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.
\$150/Day; Lunch included

COVID-19 Vaccination Required

All HOW staff and volunteers are fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Participants must be fully vaccinated before joining the Day Program.

Virtual Activities for People Living with Dementia
